BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION GENERAL ON-SITE AWARD 2020 PAY SUMMARY 1 JULY 2023

Further to our <u>circular on the Annual Wage Review Decision 2023</u>, an updated Pay and Allowances Summary for the *Building and Construction General On-site Award 2010* reflecting the **5.75% increase** set by the Fair Work Commission ([2023] FWCFB 3500) is now available.

An updated National Training Wage Summary containing the new minimum wages applicable to most trainees will be available upon request shortly.

The new pay rates and allowances will apply from the start of the first full pay period on or after **1 July 2023**.

It is recommended that members compare their existing pay rates and allowances with the updated rates to ensure they are meeting minimum requirements from the effective date above.
